

Where does the profit go?

Profit is the money left AFTER you repay your investor. Cut out these three labels, tape them to jars, and give every coin a home.



The split calculator



The 50/30/20 split is a suggestion, not a law. Your family can pick different numbers. The rule that never changes: every jar gets SOMETHING.

EXAMPLE • \$20 PROFIT

SPEND	\$10.00
SAVE	\$6.00
SHARE	\$4.00
EVERY COIN HAS A JOB	\$20.00



Patch says: investor paid back first, ALWAYS. Then the jars. That's boss law.
