One grocery trip, one dollar store trip, and a few things you already own. About \$22 all in. This is your grown-up quick reference. Your kid still runs the real price hunt on the Supply Scout, page 12, which is where the money lesson lives.

☐ Lemons bag of about 12	~\$6
☐ Sugar one bag	~\$3

Dollar store run	THE HARDWARE
☐ Paper cups about 40, 2 packs	~\$2.50
☐ Pitchers 2, plastic is fine	~\$2.50
☐ Poster board 2 sheets, for signs	~\$2.50
☐ Thick markers	~\$1.25
☐ Cash pouch or small box for the float	~\$1.25

Borrow from home	PAY \$0
☐ Table	\$0
☐ Chair	\$0
☐ Cooler keeps the ice	\$0
☐ Ladle or big spoon	\$0
☐ Tape for the signs	\$0

ADULT STEP **The dollar store is your friend**

Everyone knows the lemons. The bit parents ask about is the gear: cups, pitchers, poster board, markers, and a cash box are all at the dollar store for about a dollar each. One trip covers the whole stand.

The launch checklist

Tick it off as you go. The whole business fits in one weekend, and every step points to the page that walks your kid through it.

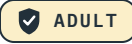
Plan first ONE WEEK BEFORE, OR A FEW DAYS

- ☐ Pick the date and check the weekend forecast
- ☐ Kid names the stand and draws the logo p.6
- ☐ Kid runs the Supply Scout price hunt p.12
- ☐ Set the price and make a prediction p.8-9
- ☐ Sign the Investor Loan IOU together p.20

Prep day THE DAY BEFORE

- ☐ Two shopping trips: grocery, then dollar store
- ☐ Run the Recipe Lab taste test p.7
- ☐ Color signs, cut tags, practice the pitch p.10,13-17
- ☐ Make a \$10 float in ones and quarters

Open day SATURDAY MORNING

- ☐ Buy the ice this morning so it survives
- ☐  ADULT Juice lemons, handle knives and hot water
- ☐ Set up table, signs, cash pouch, tally sheet
- ☐ Sell! Tally every single cup p.18

Payout ritual AFTER CLOSING

- ☐ Count the cash together, out loud
- ☐ Repay the investor, stamp the IOU PAID p.20
- ☐ Split profit into Spend, Save, Share p.19
- ☐ Fill How It Went and the certificate p.11,22
- ☐ Earn the patch! p.21



Patch says: tape this checklist to the fridge. Ticking the last box feels almost as good as the first sale.
